

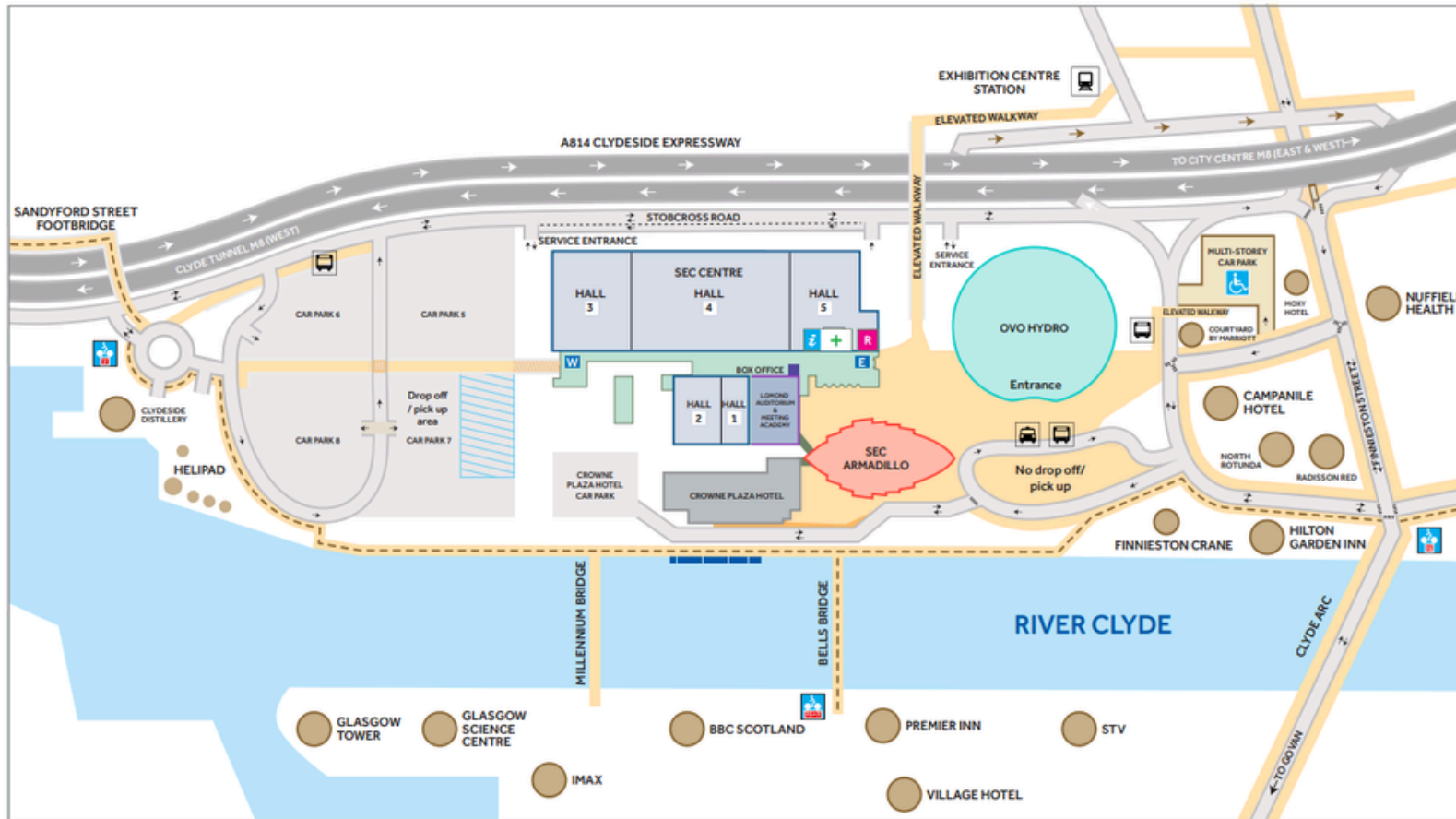

# ARRIVAL GUIDE

## OVO HYDRO, GLASGOW

### LOW EMISSION ZONE

From 1st June 2023, the Glasgow City Centre Low Emission Zone (LEZ) will come into force. If you're driving to the Scottish Event Campus (SEC) via the City Centre you may be subject to a charge, so please check your route and vehicle compliance before travelling. ### DROP-OFF / PICK-UP



The OVO Hydro drop-off/pick-up zone is located at the west of SEC Centre, as shown on the map to the right. The drop-off/pick-up zone is accessible via Stobcross Road. OVO Hydro is conveniently situated for motorists, just off the M8 motorway and with plenty of parking.

### DROP-OFF / PICK-UP ACCESSIBILITY



The drop-off/pick-up zone runs an accessible transfer service to the OVO Hydro, dropping off within 130m of the OVO Hydro south main entrance. Accessible toilets are available within 50 metres of the drop-off/pick-up zone.

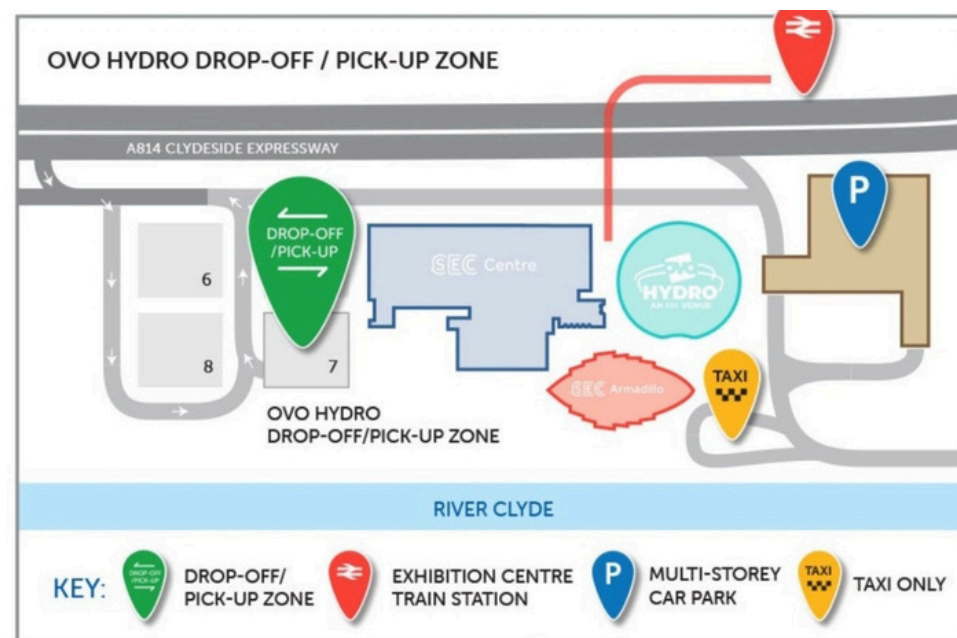
### LONG TERM PARKING / ACCESSIBLE PARKING

All longer term parking must be in the multistorey car park located on Finnieston Street, adjacent to the OVO Hydro.

### TRAIN



Once in the City Centre, the SEC is a three-minute train ride from Glasgow Central. If you arrive at Queen Street, you'll need to walk or get a bus to Central to continue your journey by train. The SEC has its own dedicated railway station—Exhibition Centre—allowing easy access from the City Centre and suburbs. There are six trains an hour (around every 10 minutes) from Glasgow Central station, departing from Platform 17 (low level).

## OVO HYDRO, GLASGOW

### **BUS**



Coach operators run services to Glasgow's Buchanan bus station from throughout the UK. The X19 stagecoach service operates near to the SEC, stopping on Finnieston Street only a few minutes' walk from the venues.



### **TAXI SERVICE**

There is a Glasgow Taxis pick-up and drop-off point outside the SEC Armadillo. There are several taxi ranks throughout the city including at Buchanan bus station, Queen Street and Central stations, and most large hotels.



### **BIKE**

Glasgow is a great cycling city. With a Nextbike station located outside the venue and multiple cycling paths, the campus is easily accessible for cyclists.



### **PLANE**

Glasgow is served by three international airports offering flights from more than 150 destinations: Glasgow Airport (GLA), Glasgow Prestwick Airport (EGPK, PIK), and Edinburgh Airport (EDI).



### **WALKING**

Glasgow is a very walkable and easy-to-navigate city. The Clyde Walkway runs right past the SEC.



### **BOAT**

Ferries serving Scotland include the Caledonian MacBrayne Ltd., with services between the Inner and Outer Hebrides and mainland Scotland. The Pentland Ferries serving Stromness in the Orkney Islands, and the NorthLink Ferries, with daily services between both Orkney (Kirkwall) and Shetland and ports in northeast Scotland.

Q. Do I need a ticket for the venue?

A. No, it is not a ticketed event.

Q. When will doors open?

A. Doors will open at 4:30 p.m.

Q. What is the dress code?

A. The dress code for the event is casual.

Q. What are the security protocols?

A. There will be bag checks and metal detector scans. Please allow additional time for this process.

Q. What items are prohibited by the venue?

A. You may not bring bags larger than A4 size and with no more than 2 compartments into the arena.

Q. Is coat or bag storage available inside the venue?

A. No.

Q. Can children and babies come to the event?

A. Yes, we welcome all ages to come; however, be aware that some of the music may be loud.

Q. Will there be any language translation?

A. Yes, there will be simultaneous translation into Cantonese, Mandarin, and Tamil. Seating and headset pickup is in the main hall. Please follow the signs.

Q. Will there be assistance for the hearing impaired?

A. Yes, there will be sign language interpretation and stewards will direct you to seating.

Q. Is there a designated area inside the venue for those with mobility requirements?

A. Yes, on arrival a steward will direct you to Accessible Platforms.

Q. Are water bottles allowed inside the OVO Hydro?

A. No. Food or drink purchased outside OVO Hydro are not permitted to be taken inside. However, there are food stands in the OVO Hydro where food and drink can be purchased, including water bottles.

Q. Will there be food and drinks available for purchase in the SEC?

A. Food and drinks are available for purchase in the SEC right next to the OVO Hydro. There are several coffee shops, a restaurant, and a shop.

Q. If my church is organizing a Group Booking and I am registered as a steward, can I come with them at door opening time?

A. No, stewards' responsibilities and assignments begin prior to doors opening to the public.

Q. If my church is organizing a Group Booking and I am registered as a counsellor, can I come with them at door opening time?

A. Yes, please make sure your group is seated in the arena and then make your way to the Counsellor Check-In area.

Q. Will there be free parking for volunteers?

A. There is no free parking available for volunteers. We recommend car-sharing or accessing public transport that might be a little less expensive than parking.

Q. How should I get to OVO Hydro?

A. For GPS driving directions, follow G3 8GS to reach the SEC.

Q. What is the cost of parking?

A. On-site parking is available, but you will be subject to the fees dictated by Glasgow City Council.

Multi Storey Car Park fees: 0–1 hour, £6.00; 1–12 hours, £12.00; 12–24 hours, £24.00

**UPON ARRIVAL:**

**Private Vehicles**

Follow the directional signage to the Multi Storey Car Park. The multistorey has a height restriction of 2m.

**Accessible Parking**

The main car park is the multistorey at 10 Stobcross Rd., G3 8YW, which is operated by Glasgow City Council. The car park is open 24 hours and has designated blue badge parking bays spread across levels 0–4. Designated car parking bays cannot be reserved for individual use. The car park has an accessible walkway attached that takes you directly to the campus. Lifts are available to gain access to each level of the carpark as well as for exiting and entering the carpark walkway, making it fully accessible at all ends.

The total distances from the Multi Storey Car Park to each of the venues are as follows:

OVO Hydro South entrance/exit: 128m

SEC Centre East entrance/exit: 265m

SEC Centre Hall 5: 307m

SEC Centre Hall 4/Hall 2: 360m

SEC Centre Hall 3: 482m

## **Accessibility Access**

The OVO Hydro has two dedicated accessible entrances located at the East Doors and West Doors of the venue. Any customer with accessible requirements is welcome to utilise either entrance, regardless of their ticket location for the event. The first two floors of the OVO Hydro are fully accessible with lifts and automated doors.

- All entry doors East, South, and West into OVO Hydro are wide for accessible users.
- All exit doors East, South, and West into OVO Hydro are wide for accessible users.
- Broad, flat, accessible concourse

## **Bus/Coach Parking:**

The buses will park at car park 7 and 8. They will park and stay for the duration of the event. Passengers will be guided to the venue.

## **For Public Transportation:**

**Train:** Once in the City Centre, the SEC is a three-minute train ride from Glasgow Central. The SEC has a dedicated railway station, Exhibition Centre—from there it's a short two-minute walk to the OVO Hydro.

**Public Bus:** The X19 stagecoach service operates near to the SEC, stopping on Finnieston Street only a few minutes' walk from the venues.
